### Detailed Rationale

The rating revision is because of lack of adequate information regarding Curo India Private Limited performance and hence the uncertainty around its credit risk. Infomerics assesses whether the information available about the entity is commensurate with its rating and reviews the same as per its policy.

Infomerics has been regularly following up with the company to provide the required data including Cash flow, bank statements and other data to monitor its assigned rating to the bank facilities, vide multiple E-mail communications latest by November 04, 2020 and concurrently over several phone calls. However, despite repeated requests by Infomerics, the company's management has not submitted the essential details. Accordingly, the lenders, investors and other users of this rating are requested to exercise adequate caution while using this rating as this rating may not adequately reflect the current credit risk profile of the company.

### Non-cooperation by Issuer

Availability of information is very critical in rating exercise. In the absence of the requisite information, in consonance with SEBI guidelines, Infomerics has to assign the rating based on the best available information. Accordingly, the long-term ratings for the bank loan facilities of Curo India Private Limited aggregating to Rs. 12.25 crore shall be moved to the 'ISSUER NOT COOPERATING' category by Infomerics and the rating be noted as IVR B+/Stable; Issuer Not Co-operating; Based on best available information (IVR B Plus/Stable outlook: Issuer Not Co-operating; Based on best available information).
